# 2. Gifted and Talented: My student tested for the GT program. What now?

# 3. IEP/Special Education: My student has an IEP. How do they get placed in the right classes?

At the end of the school year, the WMS Special Education Team, Counselors and Admin will meet with the Resource teacher at your school. That teacher will pass placement information on to make sure your student is scheduled into the right classes. WMS Counselors will assure that your student is scheduled in to the classes as they need. In many cases Transitional IEPs can be held.

# 4. I'm nervous for my student to start 7<sup>th</sup> grade. What services are available at WMS to help students with this transition?

We have several programs in place to help students feel welcome and at home at WMS:

7<sup>th</sup> Grade Day- Only 7<sup>th</sup> graders for the first day @ WMS
Pride Time- Opportunities for remediation and acceleration
Group Counseling- Groups listed on back page
Counselors- Available on individual basis for any need
Peer Leaders- Student support from other WMS students
Academic Coaches- Additional academic support
Late Bus Tuesdays- Extra time to get help after school
Extracurricular Activities- Have some fun at WMS

# 5. Math: How do I make sure my child is in the right math class?

All 7<sup>th</sup> grade students start in Intermediate Math 1.

Students interested in advanced math placement must test at WMS on March 23 <u>OR</u> March 24. The testing will start at 4:30 at WMS in room A101. It takes approximately 2 hours. Registration will be online, please watch the WMS website to register. <u>Willowcreek.alpineschools.org</u>
